# TABLETOP EXERCISE: Violent Critical Incident Response and Recovery for Long-Term Care & Healthcare Facilities

## Overview:

Building off last spring's Active Shooter Planning Considerations Workshop, this tabletop exercise will have attendees examine their response, recovery, and/or continuity of operations plans through the lens of responding to and recovering from a violent critical incident. While the workshop included elements regarding immediate response/surviving such an event, the tabletop exercise will focus on the immediate aftermath, continuity of operations, and long-term recovery.

This exercise is designed for long-term care and healthcare facility planning teams, and will be facilitated by instructors from Tactical EMS. We will also be joined by representatives from law enforcement to promote discussion and share perspectives.

## Target Audience:

Administrators who establish or implement policy; personnel who hold safety and emergency planning or response roles; any other facility staff who serve as emergency preparedness or response team members.

***We strongly encourage facilities to send planning teams equipped with copies of their response, recovery, and or continuity of operations plans as currently written.***
